- theme: The Results of Sin / The Rewards of Obedience

► Sin results in a depraved mind, depraved behaviors

- OT examples: sin, results in vile behavior little sin result sin bigger sin. . . .
 - Solomon's pride and sensuality: resulted in pagan idolatry (1 Ki. 11:1-13)
 - Rehoboam's pride: not listen to elders, make Israel's labor harder, resulting in division of kingdom
 - Jeroboam's pride: golden calves, idolatry, so people not go to Jerusalem to worship
 - 400 prophets of Baal's idolatry: when challenged by Elijah, leaped about and cut selves till blood gushed
 - Ahab's greed: murdered Naboth to get his vineyard
 - Jonah's evil desire for enemies to die rather than repent and be saved: tried to run from God

- Rom. 1:21-23, 24, 28 if people cast God out of their lives, He gives them over to depraved behaviors
 Rom. 1:25, 26-27 e.g., idolatry, homosexuality USA
 - Rom. 1:29-32 Paul's description of them USA
- **Eph. 4:17-20** Christians are different, not walk in the way of the world note: description
 - vs. 19 greediness nature of sin, grows and grows in one's life drugs, never satisfied
 - illus.: drunkenness, partying people act stupid, thinking they're cool
 - 1 Pet. 4:3-5 drunkenness, carousing, drinking parties (e.g., social drinking, going t part and not drinking)
 - pic: drunken fool thinks cool but isn't, acts stupid, laughing stock

- illus.: false teachers - use warped logic and ideas to entrap people e.g., Rehoboam, calves, like when came out of Egypt

- 2 Pet. 2:2, 12-14, 18-19 deceiving people with sinful lusts, warped behaviors

- application: must keep selves pure, to keep our thinking (minds) as it should be - holy, righteous

► Sin results in division

- OT examples:
 - Solomon's idolatry and Rehoboam's pride: resulted in divided kingdom
 - prophets righteousness: resulted in separation (division) from Israel, social and religious outcasts (illus.: Jesus)
 - Israel's sinful alliances with other nations: resulted in separation (division) from God's
- Iessons for today:
 - church
 - Tit. 3:10-11 to cause division is sin
 - 1 Cor. 11:18-19 when sin exists in a congregation, division is necessary, so approved are evident family

- Matt. 19:3-9 broken homes

- Jews had broken homes (divorce) for other than adultery, because of sin (hardness of hearts)
- illus.: Athaliah (ath-a-li'-a), daughter of Jezebel, murdered her grandchildren for power (throne)
- friends spend more time on for young people, peer pressure

- 2 Cor. 6:14, 17-18 must separate ourselves from sinful associations – behavior, not location

- 1 Cor. 5:12-13 yet live in the world, not become hermits in cave somewhere
- Eph. 5:7-13 to be a light living among, but different from
- Lk. 9:23 cost of discipleship deny self, take up cross daily
- illus.: person becomes Christian, refuses to participate with friends in sin as before, slowly they don't
- invited him to go out, then don't talk to him anymore, then not friends any more
- our responsibility when these are converted rejected by friends, family, co-workers
- separation (division) from God
 - illus.: Adam and Eve, sin, death, resulted in separation from God
 - Rom. 6:23 wages of sin death separation from God
 - 2 Th. 1:6-9 eternal separation, punishment those not know God or obey gospel
 - **Rev. 20:15** anyone's whose name not found in book of life cast into the lake of fire -2^{nd} death

- stay focused: don't play with sin
 - results in a warped mind (depraved)
 - results in separation from God

- inv.: if in sin today, separated from God, only one way to become united with Him - obey - Jesus take your sin to the cross and set you free
