## ➤ Intro:

- What are some very broad lessons we can glean from Jesus' life, and apply to our lives?
- ➤ Jesus is our example pattern
  - 1 Pet. 2:21-23 Jesus, example, way to live, even when treated unfairly
    - 1 Pet. 2:24 what Jesus did, so we can walk in His steps, ending in heaven
    - 1 Pet. 2:25 what we must do return to Jesus (obey), Shepherd and Guardian of our souls
  - Heb. 12:1b-4 run, fix your eyes on Jesus, motivation and goal, not grow weary, even if our blood is shed
  - illus.: song #29 (s), "You Are My All In All" review verses
- ➤ We are humble and self-sacrificing, like Jesus example
  - Phil. 2:5-8 humility of Jesus, emptied self, born, life as slave, cross delineate, see following
    - Matt. 11:28-30 Jesus, calls us to come and take his yoke, gentle and humble in heart, His yoke is easy and His burden is light
    - Matt. 8:20 poverty, had no place to lay His head, homeless
    - Matt. 27:46 on cross, suffered, all alone, even Father not help, so we could be saved
  - Matt. 16:24b-25 (Jesus) "If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must deny himself, and take up his cross and follow Me."
    - **Jesus** humbly emptied Himself, denied Himself for a time of the blessings as God in heaven, and **we** must deny ourselves
    - Jesus humbly took up His cross, we must take up our cross, follow Jesus
  - Are you a humble and self-sacrificing person like Jesus!

- ➤ We are obedient, like Jesus example
  - Heb. 5:7-8 Jesus learned obedience, suffering, personal sacrifice, doing things not walk to do delineate
    - as Jesus had to learn obedience, so we have to learn obedience slave not greater than master
    - Jesus learned obedience through suffering, so do we Ja. 1:2-4
    - illus.: men train horses to be obedient through the things they suffer (source unknown, SermonIllustrations.com)
      - Arabian horses go through rigorous training in the deserts of the Middle East.
      - The trainers require absolute obedience from the horses, and test them to see if they are completely trained.
      - The final test is almost beyond the endurance of any living thing. A trainer forces the horses to go without water for days. Then he turns them loose, and of course they start running toward the water, but just as they get to the edge, ready to plunge in and drink, the trainer blows his whistle.
        - The horses who have been completely trained and who have learned perfect obedience, stop.
        - They turn around and come pacing back to the trainer.
        - They stand there quivering, wanting water, but they wait in perfect obedience.
        - When the **trainer is sure they're completely obedient, even to the death, he gives them a signal** to **go back and drin**k.
      - We learn obedience through the things we suffer, just as Jesus learned, which also serves as a test, demonstrating our love and obedience to God, in each and every trial!
  - Heb. 5:9 we are obedient to Jesus, saved His word (Jn. 12:48)
    - Acts 6:7 obedient to the faith
    - Rom. 6:17 from the heart
    - 2 Cor. 2:9 in all things
    - 1 Pet. 1:14 obedient as children
    - Rev. 2:10 even if results in physical death
    - illus.: obedience demonstrated by a well-trained dog (source: Daily Bread, SermonIllustrations.com) total, complete, death
      - Archibald Rutledge wrote that one day he met a man whose dog had just been killed in a forest fire.
      - Heartbroken, the man explained how it happened.
        - Because he **worked out-of-doors**, **he often took his dog** with him.
        - One morning, he left the animal in a clearing and gave him a command to stay and watch his lunch, while he went into the forest.
        - The dog understood, and that's exactly what he did.
        - Then a fire started in the woods, and soon the blaze spread to the spot where the dog had been left, but he didn't move. He stayed right where he was, in perfect obedience to his master's word.
        - With tearful eyes, the dog's owner said, "I always had to be careful what I told him to do, because I knew he would do it."
      - our obedience to God must be like that of a well trained dog
        - God has commanded it, and expects us to obey, even if we die doing it
  - Are you obedient to God, in every respect, like Jesus? -death

- ➤ Our mission is to seek and save the lost, like Jesus example
  - Lk. 19:9-10 (Jesus to Zaccheus) His mission was to seek and save the lost
    - Jn. 3:16 Jesus' sole reason for coming to earth, save souls
  - 1 Tim. 3:15 purpose of the church, pillar and support of truth, results in salvation
    - Matt. 28:18-20; Mk. 16:16 fulfill commission to the apostles, make disciples, teach, results in salvation
    - Matt. 5:14-16 light of the world, shining before men, who glorify God because of our good works
  - Is your mission the same as Jesus' obey God, serve Him, seek and save the lost with God's word?
    - illus.: watching someone baptized into Christ
    - illus.: helping someone grow and mature as a Christian
  - Where does helping people be saved rank in your priorities, as you go about your daily duties?
    - Is it your mission?
- ➤ God exalts us at the proper time, as He exalted Jesus example
  - Phil. 2:9-11 Christ exalted for eternity
    - God exalted Jesus by raising Him from the dead
    - exalted Jesus by placing Him at His right hand, upon His throne, where He is right now, and shall remain for eternity
  - as God's chosen people, we're exalted by God as His children
    - Eph. 2:6-7 God raises us up with Christ, heavenly places (Col. 2:12), so that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus
    - Rev. 2:26-27 we're given authority over the nations, and rule them with a rod of iron, as Christ also received authority from His Father
    - Rev. 5:10 Christ has made us into a kingdom and priests to our God, and we reign upon the earth
    - 1 Cor. 6:2-3 we'll judge the world and angels
    - Rev. 22:1-5 we'll worship God and Jesus, throne their throne, for eternity
  - As a faithful Christian, God is exalting you right now, every moment of every day! And He'll exalt you much more in eternity! made possible because of Jesus' sacrifice
    - Do you realize it?
    - Do you live like it?
    - Do you act like it?
