- How important will earthly things be to you after living in eternity 100 trillion years?
 - illus.: 90 years compared to 100 trillion years = one one-millionth of a second compared to 90 years
 - i.e.: life on earth compared to 100 trillion years in eternity will seem like one one-millionth of a second on earth
- ➤ Godly paradigm of earthly life short stay
 - 1 Pet. 1:17 godly paradigm of life stay (sojourn, KJ) brief, short
- ➤ -1 Pet. 2:11 we live here as aliens and strangers not permanent home cf. heaven
 - illus.: what we do when were only going to stay somewhere a short time vs. long stay
 - take suitcase with clothes to wear for short time
 - not plan to be there permanent, all plans helping work toward returning home
- ➤ Ja. 4:14 life like vapor not know what your life will be tomorrow
 - illus.: adult life described as ten days of testing (Rev. 2:10) short complete period of time
 - illus.: Kalamazoo, 17-year-old Brittany Mattmiller was killed by a drunk driver (attached)
- ➤ Heb. 11:9-10, 13-16 men of faith upon the earth aliens and strangers, pilgrims R 1 Pet. 1:1a
 - Are you a spiritual sojourner on earth, or a permanent resident? Are you a man (woman) of faith?
- ➤ Portrait of a spiritual sojourners upon the earth, we will. . . . tell you about yourself
 - **1 Pet 1:1a, 2** saved by God, obey
- ➤ -1 Pet. 1:3-4 born again, living hope, inheritance, protected by the power of God
- ➤ -1 Pet. 1:6, 8b rejoice, even when we are tested with fire stronger, protected by God
- ➤ -1 Pet. 1:13-14a prepared mind, as obedient child
- ➤ -1 Pet. 1:17b-19 fear, redeemed with blood of Jesus
- ➤ -1 Pet. 1:22a purified your soul in obedience to the truth
- ➤ -1 Pet. 1:23 born again through the living word of God
 - spiritual sojourn so good because of where headed heaven, eternal life
- ➤ Spiritual sojourners press on to the prize heaven, eternal life
 - Phil 3:7-8, 12-14 press on, live in the present forgetting what is behind, prize
- illus.: R Heb. 11:13-16, 32-40 examples of people who pressed on to the prize
- ➤ Heb 12:1-3 we press on (race) by keeping our eyes on Jesus
- ➤ Spiritual sojourners are ready to die, every moment of ever day! life a vapor, not know what tomorrow will bring
 - Matt. 24:36-39, 44 Jesus, teaching, be ready
- illus.: parable of the sensible and foolish slaves be ready at all times Matt. 24:45-51
- illus.: parable of the ten virgins only enter if ready Matt. 25:1-13
- ► illus.: parable of the talents judgment Matt. 25:14-30
- ➤ Heb. 9:27 die, judgment no second chances illus.: child, trouble, "can I have a second chance?"

- ➤ Spiritual sojourners are citizens of God's household.
 - Eph. 2:4-5, 8 grace, made alive together with Christ Col. 2:12-13, when baptized
- ➤ Eph. 2:13 brought near by blood of Christ not alien of God, because Jesus. . . .
- ➤ Eph. 2:19-22 no longer strangers and aliens, but citizen's of God's household temple, God dwell your choice: sojourner on earth and citizen of heaven, or. . . .
