I want to be a Christian because I don't want to suffer eternal punishment!

Intro:

- → illus.: man goes to the doctor, doctor finds out he's got cancer and is going to die in a few weeks
 - **Doctor:** "Do you want me to tell you the truth, or tell you a lie?"
 - ! Man: "Tell me the truth. If I'm going to die, I want to know it, so I can prepare."
 - ! This morning: I'm going to tell you the truth
 - ! you might want to know, so you can prepare for eternity
- → There are a lot of reasons people want to be a Christian. In this series, we explore a few of the most common reasons, people want to be Christians.
 - ! first lesson: love God
 - ! last lesson talked about one reason for wanting to be a Christian go to heaven
 - ! this lesson talk about the opposite reason for wanting to be a Christian not be punished eternally, go to hell
 - ! purpose / convince: think about hell (eternal punishment), foster an increased desire to faithfully serve God as a Christian so that you will not live with the devil for eternity in hell
- ➤ #1 Who will live with the devil for eternity be punished in hell forever?
 - → The people who have not washed their robes will be punished for eternity. started using same passage in last lesson cf. lesson last week
 - **!** Rev. 22:13-15 lesson last week, Jesus' conclusion and invitation wash robe in the blood of the lamb (Rev. 7:14; baptized, Acts 22:16), outside is hell
 - → **Summary:** Who will live with the devil for eternity be punished in hell forever?
 - ! The people who have **not been washed in the blood of the Lamb**, **not obeyed** Jesus in baptism, departed from this life as faithful servants of Jesus Christ.
 - ! Question (end of lesson): Are you one of the people who will live with the devil forever in hell or will you live forever in heaven with God?
- > #2 Most people will not go to heaven, they'll be punished with the devil for eternity! sad, can be easily avoided
 - → Last lesson: There's a cost associated with being a Christian.
 - ! Summarize Matt. 16:24-25 take up cross not always going to be easy
 - ! Summarize Matt. 10:34-38 take up cross Jesus never intended it to be easy
- ➤ Jesus tells us most people will not be willing to pay to cost of being a Christian most will take the easy road to hell.
 - ! Matt. 7:13-14 not easy, few willing to pay cost, few saved but many lost
 - ! the road to heaven is narrow, the road to hell is broad
 - ! do what Jesus commands to go to heaven (Heb. 5:9)
 - ! do whatever you want to go to hell
 - ! saying: "The road to hell is paved with good intentions."
 - ! many people in hell wanted to do the right thing (obey Jesus), but never did
 - ! Matt. 7:21-23 determining factor do will of Father, talks the talk, even miracle workers
 - ! one difference between one who goes to heaven vs. one who goes to hell do will of Father
 - ! stat: surprise at judgment
 - **Gallop Poll** (U.S. News & World Report, Mar. 25, 1991)

- ! People who say they have no religion:
 - ! 61% say they have an excellent to good chance of going to heaven
 - ! 9% say they are headed to hell
- **→** Questions:
 - ! Are you going to be different from most people and obey God?
 - ! Are you going to take the easy way out and follow the crowd disobey God.
 - ! If you died today, would you open your eyes in eternity a place of tortuous punishment, or a place of eternal rest?
 - ! Are you going to be one of the many people who are surprised at judgment? think going to heaven, but find out you're going to hell
- > #3 If you are not a Christian (or not a faithful Christian) when you die, what will happen after your death?
 - → The minute you die, you'll be tortured in Hades. not get to wait know your fate immediately (eternal punishment, torment illus.: if died today)
 - ! Teaching prior to Jesus' story about the rich man and Lazarus
 - ! Story Lk. 16:1-15 prior to the story of the rich man and Lazarus
 - ! story of a rich man and his shrewd manager
 - ! one lesson: serve God with your money, if you don't, you won't be saved
 - ! Pharisees' reaction:
 - ! Quote Lk. 16:14-15
 - ! Jesus proceeds to tell them the story of Lazarus and the rich man, which exemplifies His teaching (vs. 1-15)
 - ! Jesus tells the story of the rich man and Lazarus
 - ! Read Lk. 16:19-31
 - ! vs. 19 rich man, like Pharisees who scoffed at Jesus, spent money on personal luxuries and did not help the poor
 - ! vs. 20-21 Lazarus, a poor man whom the rich man did not help did not use his \$ in service to God
 - ! vs. 22 both men die immediately in a place of comfort or torment
 - ! Lazarus in Abraham's bosom, place of comfort and rest
 - ! vs. 23-26 rich man tortured, no relief
 - ! vs. 27-31 to escape torment we must hear God's word and obey
- ➤ → When Jesus comes to earth to take the saved to heaven, you won't get to come with Him miss the reunion of loved ones with the Lord.
 - ! Last lesson: rf. 1 Th. 4:16-18 be caught up together with Jesus in the clouds, always be with the Lord
 - ! 2 Th. 1:5-8 if on earth when Jesus returns, you will be punished by His angels with flaming fire
- ➤ → Then you will be judged.
 - ! 2 Cor. 5:10 judged by Christ, after you reject His salvation and refused to obey Him)
 - ! Ec. 12:13-14 most important thing in life, fear God and keep His commandments, judgment
 - ! Rev. 20:11-13 pretend there, not a Christian emotions
- ➤ After the judgement, you will be cast into the lake of fire (hell), to spend eternity with the devil.
 - ! Rev. 20:10 Satan cast into hell after 1,000 years, after Satan released a second time, before the judgment
 - ! Rev. 20:14-15 people not faithful Christians, cast into hell with devil
 - ! feelings, thought process, if cast into lake of fire against your will
 - → Summary: If you are not a Christian when you die —

- ! The minute you die, you'll be tortured in Hades.
- ! When Jesus comes to earth to take the saved to heaven, you won't get to come with Him miss the reunion of loved ones with the Lord.
- ! Then you will be judged.
- ! After the judgement, you will be cast into the lake of fire (hell), to spend eternity with the devil.

➤ #4 What's it going to be like in hell?

- → stat: most people don't believe hell is a real place ("Hell Hath No Fury," U.S. News & World Report, 1-31-00)
 - ! 64% of Americans believe there is a hell
 - ! 25% say there isn't a hell
 - ! most respondents think of hell as "an anguished state of existence" or "an unpleasant solitary confinement" rather than as a real place
- → Life in hell will be filled with emotional torture!
 - ! Matt. 25:30 Jesus, parable talents, sentence of wicked slave to eternal punishment
 - ! outer darkness (place put for mental torture isolation no one like to be alone)
 - ! weeping and gnashing of teeth (mental anguish)."
 - ! anyone who is thrown into hell will be very sorry they did not obey God while living on earth
- ➤ Life in hell will be filled with bodily pain! what ever type of body those people will have
 - ! Matt. 13:41-42 Jesus, parable of tares, burnt up
 - ! send forth His angels (rf. 2 Th. 1:7 flaming fire)
 - ! furnace of fire (bodily pain)
 - ! there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth (same place of darkness, mental anguish).
 - ! rf. Rev. 20:10, 14 lake of fire and brimstone
 - ! illus.: punishment of Sodom and Gomorrah painful torment in hell: worn not die emotions, feelings, no relief from suffering
 - ! Mk. 9:43-48 Jesus, teaching to get sin out of our lives of spend eternity in hell, painfully tormented) place where the worn does not die
 - ! illus. Acts 12:20-26: Herod eaten alive (from the inside out) by worms
 - ! Herod did not give God the glory when the people of Tyre and Sidon cried out, "The voice of a god and not of a man!"
 - ! an angel of the Lord struck him, and he was eaten by worms and died
 - ! some ancient literature tells us that being eaten alive by worms (inside out) is one of the most painful natural deaths
 - ! illus. painful torment in hell: worn not die emotions, feelings, no relief from suffering ! e.g., cancer
- ➤ Life in hell will be eternal separation from God! most heart wenching thought of punishment
 - ! 2 Th. 1:6-10 painful punishment, not be with God, even as we are today, no goodness there
 - ! Will you be punished with flaming fire?
 - ! Or, will you glorify Jesus and marvel at Him, as His disciple, when you see Him again?

Conclusion / inv.:

- → Hell is going to be very bad (emotional torture, bodily pain). But each of us have a choice! summarize lesson
 - ! We can wash our robes in the blood of the Lamb, and faithfully serve Jesus (Rev. 7:14; Acts 22:16).
 - ! We can faithful serve Jesus, taking up our cross and following Him (Rev. 2:10-11).

- ! If we choose to serve God (last lesson):
 - ! We will reign with Christ after we die upon this earth.
 - ! We will come back with Christ when He returns to earth. And we'll meet all the saints in the air (reunited with family and friends in the Lord).
 - ! We will be judged faithful to Christ. And the Lord will take us home to heaven.
- ! If we choose to serve ourselves / Satan (this lesson):
 - ! We will be tormented in Hades the minute we die. The Lord will never relieve the pain and suffering we'll experience for our sins.
 - ! We will not come back with Christ at the end of time. We will not be united with family and friends who died in the Lord.
 - ! We will be judge unfaithful to the Lord. And we will be cast into the lake of fire to live with Stan forever eternally separated from God eternally punished for our sins.

→ Inv.:

- **! Question (end of lesson): Are you** one of the people who will live with the devil forever in hell or will you live forever in heaven with God?
 - ! not wanting to suffer for eternity is a good reason to obey God e.g., corporal discipline of children
- ! What has Jesus commanded us to do, to be saved.
 - ! **rf. Heb. 5:9** obey
 - ! What has He commanded?
- ! If we choose not to obey Jesus, we know what's going to happen.
 - ! Obey today, or pay tomorrow. Which is it going to be?
- ! Jesus invites you to come:
 - ! Rev. 22:13-14, 17 Jesus' invitation
